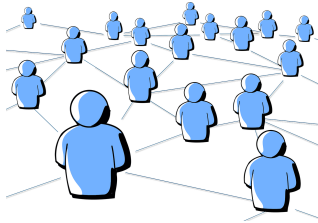


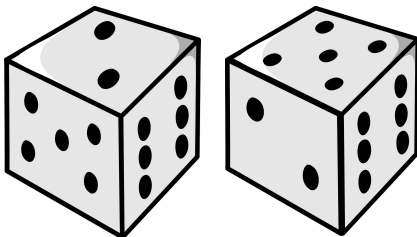
Personal Injury Litigation Timeline:
